We have a Lab, for cooking, science, music therapy, fine motor and gross motor groups.

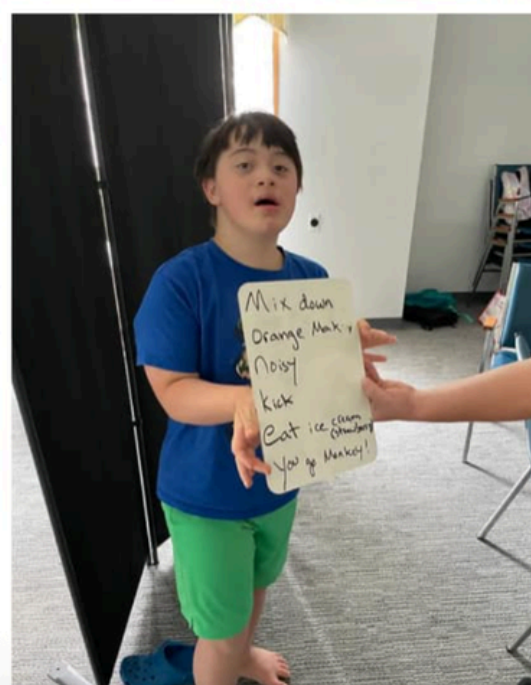
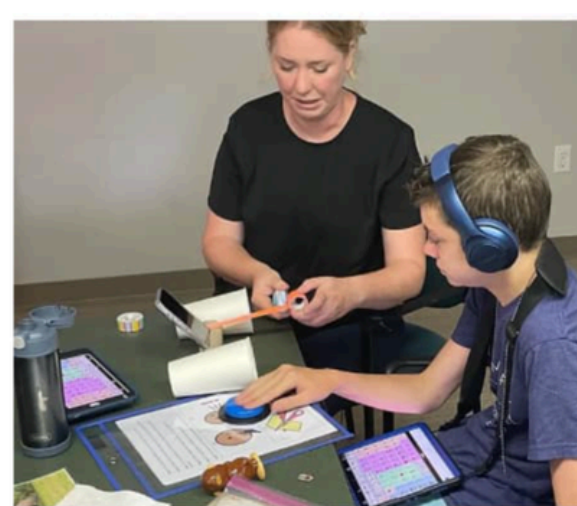
