

This year's AAC camp is online! While we wish we could meet again at the beautiful grounds of Jericho, this year needs to be a little different. Our team has put our heads together and worked to bring to life the best parts of AAC camp in an online, virtual format. Our theme is Virtual Adventures, and we will be immersed in language, vocabulary, and AAC implementation as we "travel" to different places. We will offer a combination of real-time and recorded sessions, and we will also continue to incorporate related services like we have before. Camp participants will receive printed and prepared learning kits to make sure that they have the materials and supports needed to access the curriculum and participate as fully as possible in the real-time sessions. Additionally, we will have a communication partner training element, as we believe in empowering the individual and their communication partners in order to support overall use of AAC.

Sessions and Session Formats

Camp Commūnicāre will be done using a combination of recorded (asynchronous) and real-time (synchronous) sessions created and led by our team of AAC specialists. Learning kits will be prepared and delivered before July 6th to registered participants. Recorded lessons will be available on our password-protected website and live sessions will be done using Zoom's HIPAA compliant platform.

Format	Activity Type	Activity Description			
Recorded	Daily Check-in	Our AAC specialist will review the week's vocabulary, joke of the day, and adventure challenge of the day.			
Recorded	Learning Activity	Our AAC specialist will lead a learning activity related to the theme, emphasizing the vocabulary, and incorporating the use of AAC into the lesson.			
Recorded	Related Service Special	One of our collaborating partners (either a music therapist, physical therapist, or occupational therapist) will lead a lesson designed to support a specific skill or targ area. The lesson will incorporate the theme of the week.			
Recorded	Extension Activity	One of our clinicians or collaborative partners will lead an activity designed to support generalization and implementation of AAC in different environments/contexts.			
Real Time	Group Meeting	Our AAC specialist will lead a live, real-time group session designed to support soc connectedness while overlapping with content related to the week's theme.			
Real Time	Group Activity	Our AAC specialist will lead a learning activity related to the theme. This will still emphasize the vocabulary and incorporate the use of AAC, but will be more interactive in nature.

Recorded	Communication Partner Training	Our AAC specialist will go over a portion of the communication partner curriculum.	
Recorded *	Modeled Activities	Our AAC specialist will provide modeled learning activities while incorporating communication partner strategies. These are designed to support generalization as further implementation of AAC.	
Real Time	Group Meeting	Our AAC specialist will review the topic of the week and be available for a dynamic Q+A and offer additional examples related to the topic.	

Each of the activities/sessions will be 20-30 minutes in duration (with the exception of the Modeled Activities as part of the Communication Partner Training).

Registration and Purchasing Options

There are lots of ways to enjoy Camp Commūnicāre this summer. One way is that individuals using AAC can sign up as a camp participant. Registered participants will be assigned to virtual groups, which will be led by an AAC specialist and 1-2 graduate student clinicians. Camp participants get access to 5 weeks of pre-recorded content, printed learning kits (which will be mailed/delivered in advance of camp), a camp t-shirt, as well as a Curriculum Guide and additional resources related to the curriculum. Participants will be part of a group of other campers that will have virtual group meetings and activities scheduled Monday through Thursday during the weeks of camp. Additionally, as part of the curriculum, campers and their communication partner team will have access to a comprehension communication partner webinar, as well as a recorded lesson and virtual meeting each week of camp.



You can also buy the Camp Curriculum. Purchasing this option will offer access to all of the recorded content (Daily Check-ins, Learning Activities, Related Service Specials and Extension Activities for the week). Links will be provided for purchasers to download, print and prepare the curriculum content, supplementary support materials, and visuals. Or, you can supplement your own programming by getting just the Extension Activities.
